Compliance Time: Prior to but not later than the next 100 hours of operation

Purpose: To provide instructions for an inspection of the fuselage center bottom skin at the aft section assembly.

Instructions: Inspect fuselage aft section assembly bottom center skin to ascertain that one quarter inch (.250) minimum rivet edge distance has been maintained at the forward end (station 192.38).

If the rivet edge distance is less than one quarter inch (.250), Kit No. 760 324 Fuselage Aft Section Modification, must be installed. Please refer to sketch on reverse side of this bulletin for general information.

Material Required: One (1) each Kit No. 760 324 Fuselage Aft Section Modification, as required.

Availability of Parts: Piper Dealer

Material Allowance: One (1) each Kit No. 760 324 Fuselage Aft Section Modification, as required; comply with Service Publication Compliance/Credit Request procedure.

Labor Allowance: One (1) hour for installation of Kit No. 760 324; comply with Service Publication Compliance/Credit Request procedure.
