TO: All Distributors, Dealers and Owners

SUBJECT: Engine Nacelle Air Baffle

MODEL AFFECTED: PA-23 Serials 23-1 to 23-544 inclusive

An air baffle is now being installed in current production airplanes between the top of the wing front spar and the engine rear top nacelle assembly. This baffle was designed to prohibit cold air, which enters the engine nacelle through the wheel well openings, from passing through the wing cavity and into the cockpit area.

This installation has proven quite satisfactory in the field and is now available as Service Kit No. 754 139. This air baffle installation kit may be ordered through your nearest Piper distributor or dealer for a unit list price of \$20.00.

Credit for the cost of this kit will be issued upon receipt of a regular Warranty and Credit Claim for 1956 airplanes, Serials 23-376 to 23-544 inclusive.

No credit will be made for this kit installed on airplanes 23-1 to 23-375 inclusive.
